### **COURSE OVERVIEW**

This two-year Higher National Diploma (HND) offers an in-depth study of information systems development, which modern organisations rely on. The course includes practical assignments and specification-based activities, covering key areas in computer programming and software engineering, such as establishing software-based systems within a fixed or mobile environment, website design, database design, and computer-based applications. Students are required to undertake a 2<sup>nd</sup> year project, researching a topic of their choice. Successful completion of the course provides access to the final year of most BSc degrees within a related field of computer engineering or ICT\*. The course is delivered over two years and six terms, with approximately three units (modules) studied during each term:
