WHAT WILL I EXPERIENCE?

CAREER DIRECTION

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Level 3 qualification or equivalent.
- GCE Advanced level profile demonstrating strong performance in a relevant subject or an adequate performance in more than one GCE subject.
- An Access to Higher Education Certificate awarded by an approved further education institution.
- Mature learners without formal qualifications are required to present a profile of achievement in the form of 2 years related work experience (paid or unpaid) and will be subject to relevant entry assessments.
- All applicants must pass an Academic Interview.
- Proficiency in English at a standard commensurate to IELTS 5.5.
